Announcements

- 1) We are encouraged to go to confession during Advent and Lenten seasons. Please make an appointment with Fr. Raul or Fr. Lorenzo for a confession before coming to the church.
- 2) The revised Japanese text of the Order of Mass was authorized by the Holy See, and the new text has been used in all Japanese Masses in Japan since the First Sunday of Advent, November 27th. There are some changes from the former expressions, so please be aware of this when you attend Japanese Masses.
- 3) Due to the downward trend in the number of new cases of Covid-19, our parish council decided to discontinue the entry of participants' names and contact details at all Masses from October onwards. Therefore, it is not necessary for the English Mass participants to fill out the participation form as of November.
 - However, as the pandemic is not over yet, we ask for your continual cooperation in the following infection control measures. Thank you.
- 4) The following are required during the resumption of Masses with the congregation.
 - Please wear a face mask before you enter the church compound. Face masks should be worn throughout the celebration of the Mass and should be worn properly covering both the mouth and nose completely.
 - Please sanitize your hands when entering and leaving the church.
 - Please sit where you are assigned and maintain at least 1.5 to 2 meters of social distance from others at all times while in the church.
 - For now, Holy Communion will only be given in your hands.
